Open to Everyone

Flower Show School II is open to everyone.
Each of the 4 Flower Show School courses has
an optional exam. NGC members wishing to
apply to be NGC Flower Show Judges must
take all four courses and pass each exam and
must affiliate with an NGC Garden Club in
order to be eligible to receive credit towards a
Nationally Accredited Judges Certificate.
