Judges must bring *The Handbook for Flower Shows, 2017 revised*. All in-person and virtual lectures must be attended to receive credit toward certification.

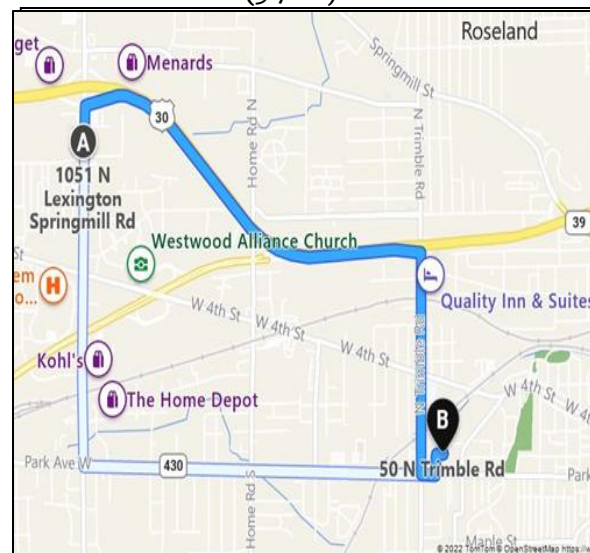

She is a life member of WVGC & NGC & a member of the American Horticulture, Hosta, & Daffodil Societies. She serves on the NGC Board of Directors as the Horticulture Instructors Chairman & a member of the Special Projects committee. On the state level she is the WV Flower Show Schools Chairman & Judges Chairman. In 2001, she founded the annual Community Thanksgiving Meal Project. To date, hundreds of volunteers have provided over 25,000 hot meals on Thanksgiving Day. Darlene is a retired RN & nursing home administrator.
